The building is in use seven days a week. Activities include: *The Warm Welcome Café*, *Castle Brass Wind Band*, *Yoga*; *Short Mat Bowls*, *Riverhouse Life Church*, *Mindfulness Meditation*, *Chloe's Youth Theatre* and much, much more...

Annual running costs are met through income from room hire. Management, maintenance and cleaning rely entirely on the efforts of our friends and volunteers.
